


Holy Spirit Anglican Church

Ways to Serve at Holy Spirit

Altar Guild: Foster the sense of holiness in worship as you prepare the Lord's Table for Communion before the service, clean the table afterwards, and attend to the general upkeep and beautification of God's sanctuary. See Guida Switzer for more info.

Hospitality: Build and encourage deeper fellowship in our community by providing food, setting up, and cleaning up after hospitality hour. Contact the church office for more info.

Music Ministry: Be a part of the team that leads the community into the presence of God through worship. See Jordan Wewer for more info.

Prayer Team: Stand with others before the Lord to present their needs and listen to the Holy Spirit on their behalf. See Rev. Neil for more info.

Reader: Convey God's heart to His people through the reading of His Word during the service. See Rev. Neil Taylor for more info.

Sunday School: Help Kay Ference as she disciples our grade school kids on Sunday mornings during the sermon. Please see Kay for more info.

Tech Ministry: Computer savvy? Interested in AV? We need those who can monitor the sound board, run the camera, and run the slides during the service. See Ryan Griffin for more info


