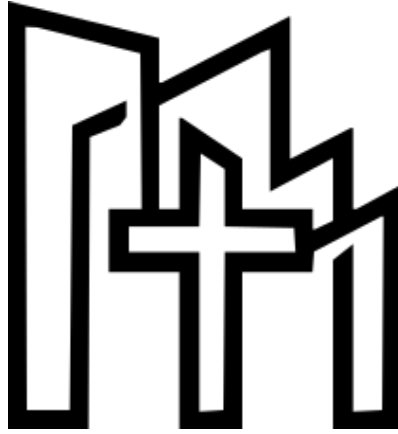


Holy Spirit Anglican Church

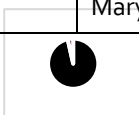

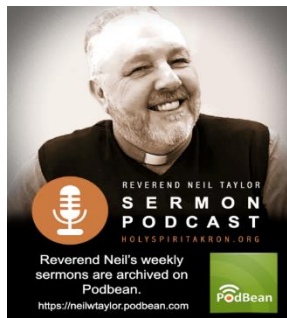


